The Circle of Care Foundation is a California non-profit benefit corporation whose leadership and volunteers are dedicated to fulfilling the health care needs of our community

The Circle of Care Foundation supports the Grossman Burn Center at Sherman Oaks Hospital, S+AGE programs for seniors, and the Circle of Care Leeza's Place.

The Grossman Burn Center has been dedicated to providing the most specialized and targeted care to burn patients and their loved ones since 1969. Through support provided by the **Circle of Care Foundation**, a nearby apartment is available for families of burn patients so they may be close to their loved ones during treatment. Every year, the Grossman Burn Center hosts an annual 3-day weekend family camp funded primarily by **COCF**, a safe and fun environment where burn survivors have an opportunity to build confidence and independence. **COCF** also helps fund burn prevention and education programs.

S+AGE is the Specialized Ambulatory Geriatric Evaluation Program at Sherman Oaks Hospital. The **Circle of Care Foundation** raises funds to support free memory testing and senior health evaluations, as well as community outreach programs and support groups. **COCF** is also proud to provide for the development, implementation and ongoing evaluation of a Care Consultation Program which provides assistance to each S+AGE patient and their caregiver through consultation visits, caregiver training and support, and telephone follow-up.

The Circle of Care Leeza's Place in Sherman Oaks is a **COCF** funded facility. It is an intimate and safe setting where caregivers and those recently diagnosed with a memory disorder can gather for education and support. The Circle of Care Leeza's Place was developed in response to the challenges Leeza Gibbons and her family encountered while seeking needed support in dealing with Alzheimer's Disease.

The Circle of Care Foundation, through its annual gala, *Dreams on Canvas*, has raised more than \$800,000 since its inception in 2004. The **COCF Sustainer Angels** program allows individuals to participate and support the **Circle of Care Foundation** through a fixed annual donation. With a new web site, quarterly newsletter, informational video, a dedicated Board of Directors and **COCF** Community Advisors, the **Circle of Care Foundation** looks forward to expanding and deepening its commitment to building a stronger community.
